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INTRODUCTION

The quarry project of **M/s Travancore Blue Metal Industries (P) Ltd.** is situated at survey No. 229/1, 229/13, 229/9, and others in Village & Panchayat - Aruvikara, Taluk - Nedumangad, District - Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

The quarry project was accorded with the Environmental Clearance (EC) by State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority on 31-03-2017. As part of general condition No.37 of Environmental Clearance order, half yearly compliance report needs to be submitted by the project proponent. The compliance report of Second half to the specific conditions and general conditions of the Environmental Clearance order for the period of **October 2022 – March 2023** is being submitted.

PART - A – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

01	Steep cliff like feature may be demarcated and fenced as danger zones with sign boards.	complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has demarcated steep cliff like feature by fencing. Sign board is also installed to know it is a danger zone. The photograph of the danger board is attached as **Plate No. 5**. This is being maintained in the project area.

02	Storm water drainage from the upper part must be channelized properly and let out through well defined channels. Catch water drain should be provided and water must be clarified to avoid silt to reach the river. Avoid letting out water beside of the approach road.	complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has constructed well defined drainages to channelize all surface runoff in to the rain water harvesting pond in the project site. The de-siltation chamber has been provided to remove sediments from the storm water. The approach road is maintained well and provided drainage channel along road side.

03	The rain water structure should be provided.	Complied
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Compliance:

The proponent has developed two rain water harvesting pond in the project site to collect rain water from the entire project land. The storm water flow is leading to the pond through constructed and natural drainages. The photograph is showing the rain water collection pond in the project area in **Plate No. 1**.

PART – B – GENERAL CONDITIONS

01	Rain Water Harvesting capacity should be installed as per the prevailing provisions of KMBR / KPBR, unless otherwise specified.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has developed rain water harvesting ponds in the quarry site as Rain Water Harvesting structure. The ponds are situated at the lowest level of project site. The surface runoff is channelized to the pond through garland drains. The rain water is used for irrigation purposes, watering of plants, wetting of roads and for dust suppression system (mainly sprinklers system). The photograph showing the rain water collection pond in the project area is attached in **Plate No. 1**.

02	Environment Monitoring Cell (EMC) as agreed under the affidavit filed by the proponent should be formed and made functional.	Complied
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Compliance:

The Environmental Monitoring Cell (EMC) was formed with Mr. Biju varghese as head of the monitoring cell. The EMC meetings of the cell convene periodically and evaluate the activities towards the stipulations of Environmental Clearance order. The details of the monitoring cell are given below in **Table No. 1**.

03	Suitable avenue trees should be planted along either side of the tarred road and open parking areas, if any, inclusive of approach road and internal roads.	complied
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Compliance:

As part of enhancing bio diversity, the project proponent has planted various saplings and native species in the project site to enhance the eco – diversity in the industry. Green belt is an important component in the mining sector. There is also natural vegetation including trees, shrubs and climbers are presents in the sides of road and parking area. This will help to reduce air and sound pollution. The photographs of avenue trees planted in the road side are given in **Plate No. 2**. The bill purchased against plants is provided as **Annexure No.1**.

04	Maximum possible solar energy generation and utilization shall be ensured as an essential part of the project.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has installed five solar street lights in the project site to use maximum renewable energy to reduce electrical consumption from KSEB. The project proponent has installed 2 solar street lights; and can feed 1 CFL and fan at security cabin to use maximum renewable energy. The purchasing bill of solar is given in **Annexure No. 14**. Photograph of Solar street light is attached as **Plate No. 11**.

05	Sprinklers shall be installed and used in the project site to contain dust emissions.	Complied
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Compliance:

To prevent dust emission, sprinklers are installed in the project site. This help to suppress dust during the time summer season. Purchase bill of sprinkler is attached as **Annexure No. 15**

06	Eco-restoration including the mine closure plan shall be done at the own cost of the project proponent.	Being complied
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Compliance:

Eco restoration is in an integral part of mining activity. The eco restoration and the mine closure plan will be done at the own cost of the project proponent as per the approved mining plan.

07	At least 10 percent out of the total excavated pit area should be retained as water storage areas and the remaining area should be reclaimed with stacked dumping and overburden and planted with indigenous plant species that are eco-friendly, if no other specific condition on reclamation of pit is stipulated in the EC.	Noted for compliance
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Compliance:

After closure of the mine, the project proponent is intending to retain 10 percent of total excavated pit as rain water storage area. The remaining area will be reclaimed with stacked dumping of overburden and top soil. As part of its eco – restoration plan, the project will plant indigenous plant species that are eco – friendly on the reclaimed area.

08	Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) agreed upon by the proponent should be implemented.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has carried out various activities under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). The project proponent has spent an amount of Rs. 2,68,660 in the period of October 2022 to March 2023. The details of performed activities under CSR is attached as **Annexure No. 16**.

09	The lease area shall be fenced off with barbed wires to a maximum height of 4ft around, before starting of mining. All the boundary indicators (boards, stores, markings etc) shall be protected at all times and shall be conspicuous.	Complied
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Compliance:

To demarcate the lease area, the project proponent has installed fencing around the area where lease obtained. The complete installation of barbed metal wire fencing around the mining area is with height of 4 ft. All the boundary indicators are protected at all times and clearly visible at any time in a noticeable way. The photograph of barbed metal wire fencing is provided in **Plate No.4**. Signboard is attached as **Plate No. 10**.

10	Warning alarms indicating the time of blasting (to be done at specific timings) has to be arranged as per stipulations of Explosive Department.	Complied
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Compliance:

As per the stipulation of Explosive department and State Environment Impact Assessment Authority the project proponent has installed warning alarms (Siren) in the quarry site. Siren is blown before and after blasting regularly. The blasting timings are displayed in the prominent area by way of caution board.

11	Control measures on noise and vibration prescribed by KSPCB should be implemented.	Complied
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Compliance:

To reduce noise level in the project site, the project proponent has implemented mitigate masseurs. The major noise generating sources from the mining activity is working machineries, drilling, blasting and plying of vehicles. The following control measures are undertaken to bringing down the noise levels:-

- Proper maintenance of machinery and equipments
- The machineries like breaker and excavator has well sound proof cabin so that the machine operators can work without stress due to the sound.

- Personal protective devices i.e., earmuffs, ear plugs etc. are provided to workers working in high noise areas.
- The mining activity held in day time only.

Blast vibrations and control measures

- ❖ Controlled blasting technique is adopted in this project in order to reduce blast vibrations.
- ❖ The maximum charge per delay is not more than 10kg to limit the PPV values to 10mm/sec.
- ❖ Optimum delay sequence and stem to column ratio is maintaining to minimize the ground vibration intensity.
- ❖ The project proponent has appointed qualified persons to monitor the mining operations

12	Quarrying activities should be limited to day time as per KSPCB guidelines/specific conditions.	complied
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Compliance:

Quarrying activities are limited to day time only as per KSPCB guidelines. This helps to limit the sound pollution. The quarry working time is 8.00am to 5.00 pm.

13	Blasting should be done in a controlled manner as specified by the regulations of explosives department or any other concerned agency.	Complied
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Compliance:

The blasting is done in controlled manner by using NONEL Technology. All blasting activities are carrying out with the specified regulations of explosive department. All blasting are under careful supervision of qualified persons.

14	A licensed person should supervise/control the blasting operations.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has appointed mines manager and mining mate in the site to supervise/control exploitation of minor minerals including blasting at the project site. **Annexure No. 2** is showing the certificate of qualified persons.

15	Access roads to the quarry shall be tarred to contain dust emissions that may arise during transportation of materials.	Complied
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Compliance:

To contain dust emissions and for the trouble free transportation of materials, the project proponent has concreted the access road of 600 meter from the entrance of project site to quarry is maintaining in good manner. The project splashes water on the road to arrest the dust production during summer season. The photograph of concreted road is provided in **Plate No. 3**.

16	Overburden materials should be managed within the site and used for reclamation of mine pits as per mine closure plan/ specific conditions.	Complied
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Compliance:

In a building stone quarry project, the overburden and topsoil need to extract during the time of mining, these natural resources are staked in the project site. This is being used for plantation, haulage roads and land filling in the mining area. No overburden is let out from the project site. To prevent soil erosion grass has been planted on the overburden and topsoil.

17	Height of the benches should not exceed 5m, and width should not be less than 5m, if there is no mention is the mining plan/specific conditions.	complied
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Compliance:

To enhance safety and conserve environment, the project proponent is extracting the minerals by creating benches. The benches does not exceed 5 meters of height. The project maintains the width of benches minimum of 5 meters. **Plate No. 6** shows the mining area.

18	Mats to reduce fly rock blast to a maximum of 10 PPV should be provided.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent is using blasting mats in the mining field during blasting time. The project proponent is using NONEL Technology for blasting therefore there is no incident of fly rock is happened in the community. The project proponent is also assuring the maximum PPV is under 10 during the time of blasting. The photograph of the blasting mat is attached as **Plate No.7**.

19	Maximum depth of mining from general ground level at site shall not exceed 10m.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent is following the approved mining plan for the exploitation of building stone. Therefore mining depth does not exceed beyond 10 meter or not below the level of the nearest stream bed, whichever is less.

20	No mining operations should be carried out at places having a slope greater than 45°.	Complied
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Compliance:

No mining operation is carried out with a slope greater than 45°.

21	Acoustic enclosures should be provided to reduce sound amplifications in addition to the provisions of green belt and hollow brick envelop for crushers so that the noise level is kept within prescribed standards given by CPCB/KSPCB.	complied
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Compliance:

To reduce the impact of sound to the labours in the mine, the project proponent has provided ear plugs. All machines are maintain regularly. Vegetation around the mining area helps to reduce noise and air pollution. This helps the noise level kept

within prescribed standards. The crusher and DG set is housed in with acoustic enclosures.

22	The workers on the site should be provided with the required protective equipments such as ear muffs, helmet, etc.	complied
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Compliance:

As part of safety, the project proponent has provided adequate Personnel Protective Equipments (PPE) such as helmets, ear plugs, safety belts, safety shoes, glows, etc. to the labours in working site. Photograph of workers with PPE is attached as **Plate No. 12**

23	Garland drains with clarifiers to be provided in the lower slopes around the core area to channelize storm water.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has constructed drains with clarifiers in the lower slopes of the project area for storm water management. The clarifiers prevent the quarry wastes entering in to the public stream. The project proponent ensured that all storm water from the mining area is flowing in to the pond created at mining area. The photograph of drain is provided in **Plate No.8**. The project proponent is intending to increase the efficiency of garland drain in the site. Photograph of de-siltation trap is provided in **Plate No.9**

24	The transportation of minerals should be done in covered trucks to contain dust emissions.	complied
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Compliance:

To avoid dust emission while transportation of materials, the project proponent is being covered the trucks before it leaving the project site.

25	The proponent should plant trees at least 5 times of the loss that has occurred while clearing the land for the project.	complied
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Compliance:

As part of concurrent eco restoration, the project proponent has planted various saplings in the project area as a compensation of loss of trees while clearing the land for mining. The bill against the purchase of plants is provided at **Annexure No.1**.

26	Disposal of spent oil from diesel engines should be as specified under relevant Rules/Regulations.	Complied
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Compliance:

The volume of used oil is low in the industry; a major portion of used oil is used as lubricant in the project site. The excess have been sold to agencies approved by Pollution Control board.

27	Explosives should be stored in magazines in isolated place specified and approved by the explosives department.	complied
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Compliance:

Explosives are stored in magazine. The magazine situated in an isolated place specified and approved by the explosives department. The area surrounded to the magazine is fenced with barbed metal wire. Same is attached as Plate No. 13

28	A minimum buffer distance of 100m meter from the boundary of the quarry to the nearest dwelling unit or other structures, not being any facility for mining shall be provided.	complied
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Compliance:

To reduce the adverse impact on community life, the norms of Kerala State Pollution Control Board regarding the distance criteria of residences, roads, rivers and worship places is adhered by the project. The project has left 115 meter distance to the nearest house from the boundary of mining area, the KSPCB condition is 50 meter.

29	100 m buffer distance should be maintained from forest boundaries.	Noted
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Compliance:

There is no forest in the 100 meter vicinity to the project site.

30	Consent from Kerala Pollution Control Board under Water and Air Act(s) should have been obtained before initiating activity.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has obtained consent from KSPCB under Water and Air Act(s). The copy of certificate of “*Consent to Operate*” (Renewal) from Kerala State Pollution Control Board is provided in **Annexure No.3**.

31	All other statutory clearances should have been obtained, as applicable, by project proponents from the respective competent authorities including that for blasting and storage of explosives.	Complied
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Compliance:

The certificates obtained from concerned statutory authorities are enclosed in **Annexure No.3, 4, 5, 6 & 7**

33	The Authority reserves the right to add additional safe guard measures subsequently, if found necessary, and to take action including revoking of the environment clearance under the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act 1986, to ensure effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures in a time bound and satisfactory manner.	Noted
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Compliance:

If the Authority insists to add additional safeguards and measures in the mining industry for safety and environmental sustainability, the project proponent will be complied with.

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Compliance:

The compliance report is being submitted along with the results of monitored data to the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority and the Regional Office of MoEF&CC, Bangalore as Email. The monitored data of Air, Water and Noise is attached as **Annexure No. 11, 12 & 13**.

38	The details of Environmental Clearance should be prominently displayed in a metallic board of 3 ft x 3ft with green background and yellow letters of Times New Roman font of size of not less than 40. Sign board with extent of lease area and boundaries shall be depicted at the entrance of the quarry, visible to the public.	complied
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Compliance:

The detail of the Environmental Clearance has display on metallic board in the project site. The metallic board installed as specified in the conditions of Environmental Clearance order.

39	The proponent should provide notarized affidavit (indicating the number and date of Environmental Clearance proceedings) that all the conditions stipulated in the EC shall be scrupulously followed.	Complied
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Compliance:

An assurance in the form of affidavit was already submitted to SEIAA Kerala. The copy of the same is attached as **Annexure No.10**.

40	No change in mining technology and scope of working should be made without prior approval of the SEIAA, No further expansion or modification in the mine shall be carried out without prior approval of the SEIAA, as applicable.	NO change in scope
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Compliance:

At present, the project proponent is not intending to expand the area of mine, technology and scope of working. The project proponent will appear SEIAA for Environment Clearance if the project proponent wants to expand its scope. The mining is progressing as per submitted plan.

41	The project proponent shall ensure that no natural water course and/or water resources shall be obstructed due to any mining operations. Necessary safeguard measures to protect the first order streams, if any originating from the mine lease shall be taken.	Complied
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Compliance:

There is no such natural water course or “thodu” is flowing along the project site. The project proponent will ensure the natural runoff of storm water. No first order stream is originating from the lease area.

42	Monitoring of Ambient air Quality to be carried out based on the notification 2009, as amended from time to time by the Central Pollution Control Board. Water sprinkling should be increased at places loading and unloading points & transfer point to reduce fugitive emissions.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has monitored the ambient air quality as per National Ambient Air quality Standard (NAAQS). The project proponent is sprinkling water at loading point after each blast, on the roads and at unloading points. The crushing plant is equipped with water sprinklers at appropriate points. This activity reduces the fugitive emission of dust.

43	The top soil, if any, shall be temporarily stored at earmarked site(s) only for the topsoil shall be used for land reclamation and plantation. The Over Burden (OB) generated during the mining operations shall be stacked at earmarked dump site(s) only. The maximum height of the dumps shall not exceed 8m and width 20m and overall slope of the dumps shall be maintained to 45°. The OB dumps should be scientifically vegetated with suitable native species to prevent erosion and surface run off. In critical areas, use of geo textiles shall be undertaken for stabilization of the dump. The entire excavated area shall be backfilled. Monitoring and management of rehabilitated areas should continue until the vegetation becomes self-sustaining.	Complied
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Compliance:

To prevent the soil erosion, the top soil and overburden are stacked in designated place within the project site. Only topsoil is being used for plantation. Overburden used for landfill and to construct haulage roads in the mining area. The excess is being stored in a designated place as per the direction of State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA). The Environment Monitoring Cell is being monitored the execution of eco restoration.

44	Catch drains and siltation ponds of appropriate size shall be constructed around the mine working, mineral and OB dumps to prevent run off of water and flow of sediments directly into the river and other water bodies. The water so collected should be utilized for watering the mine area, roads, green belt development etc., The drains shall be regularly de silted particularly after monsoon and maintained properly.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent has constructed effective garland drains to catch all the storm water during the time of monsoon season. These channels directed the water to the rain water collection pond. All sediments and silts are settling at the bottom of the pond and only cleared water is letting out. The water from the pond can be used for splashing of water on roads to arrest the dust. The project proponent indenting to create de siltation chambers along with catch drains.

45	Effective safeguard measures such as regular water sprinkling shall be carries out in critical areas prone to air pollution and having high levels of PM ₁₀ and PM _{2.5} , such as haul road, loading an un loading points and transfer points – it shall be ensured that the Ambient Air Quality Parameters confirm to the norm prescribed by the Central Pollution Control Board in this regard.	complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent is regularly spraying water in critical areas prone to air pollution with the help of vehicle and sprinklers. The project proponent has increased the number of sprinklers in critical area to reduce the dust emission such as loading and unloading points, haul roads and transfer points.

46	Fugitive dust emission from all the sources should be controlled regularly. Water spraying arrangements on haul roads, loading and unloading and at transfer point should be provided and properly maintained.	Complied
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Compliance:

The project proponent splashes water in critical area to reduce the dust emission such as loading and unloading points, haul roads and transfer points. The sprinklers and vehicle for water spraying are properly maintained.

47	Measures should be taken for control of noise levels below 85 dBA in the work environment.	complied
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Compliance:

The noise level from all these activities does not go beyond 85dBA. The main sound generating activities are the playing of jack hammer, breaker, vehicles and blasting operations. The project proponent will take appropriate action to reduce the sound by employing possible measures. These are mentioned under the condition number 11.
